Grzegorz W. Kołodko, one of the world's leading authorities on economics and development policy, will discuss his new book, *Truth, Errors, and Lies: Politics and Economics in a Volatile World* (Columbia University Press, 2011). In this book he applies an interdisciplinary framework for understanding the global economic situation. While Poland's Deputy Premier and Minister of Finance (1994-97), Kołodko led Poland into membership in the OECD. Holding the same positions again in 2002-03, he played an important role in Poland's integration with the European Union. He is currently a professor of political economy at Kozminski University in Warsaw and Director of TIGER - Transformation, Integration and Globalization Economic Research.
