Andreas Schieder has been the State Secretary at Federal Ministry of Finance of Austria since December 2008. Prior to that, he was State Secretary in the Chancellery. He has been politically active at the national and international level since his youth. In 1997, Schieder became President of the European Young Socialists (ECOSY). From 1996 to 2006, he was Member of the Municipal Council of Vienna, followed by being Member of the Austrian Parliament and International Secretary of the Social Democratic Party from 2006 to 2008. From 2007 to 2008, Schieder was Spokesperson for Foreign Affairs and Chairman of the Parliamentarian Committee on Foreign Affairs of the Social Democratic Party.
